August 24, 2020

There was a Zoom meeting of the Vestry of Saint Paul's Episcopal Church, Chestnut Hill, on the above date at 7 p.m.

There were present Clark Groome, secretary, presiding; also Assistant Rector Dan Kline, and Vestry members Chip Butler, Steve Camp-Landis, Cheyenne DeMulder, Mark Duckett, John Kimberly, George McNeely, Steve Pearson, Louise Thompson, and Hugh Williamson.

III. The minutes of the July 27, 2020, Vestry meeting were approved unanimously.



V. George McNeely reported that planning for the 2021 Stewardship Campaign was well underway.
